

Construction is continuing to improve OR 212 between I-205 and U.S. 26. Improvements include repaving OR 212 and installing ADA-compliant sidewalks, curb ramps, and pedestrian facilities at numerous locations in the project area.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Sidewalk closures with ADA-compliant pedestrian detours.
- Day and nighttime lane closures on OR 212.
- In limited areas, eastbound and westbound traffic will share one travel lane with flaggers directing drivers.
- The week of August 3, travelers will experience intermittent 20-minute traffic stops from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. on OR 212 at North Fork Deep Creek. Flaggers will direct traffic and a signed detour route will also be in place.
- **Full 24/7 closure of OR 212 for 12 days at North Fork Deep Creek for bridge installation mid-August 2020.**

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Over the past few months, we began work to improve the roadway on Oregon 212. We installed ADA-compliant sidewalk and curb ramps and repaired the road in preparation for paving. Paving began in June, starting from I-205 moving east to U.S. 26 through Damascus and Boring. ADA work and paving will continue throughout summer 2020.

Other upcoming work includes installing a fish-friendly bridge on OR 212 at North Fork Deep Creek (east of Boring).

Bridge construction will begin in late July, with a full 24/7, 12-day bridge closure on OR 212 in mid-August 2020. Specific closure dates will be posted on the website and road signs.

Daytime pile driving will take place on Monday, August 3 through Thursday, August 6 between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. on OR 212 for the new bridge. During this work, travelers will experience intermittent 20-minute traffic stops. Drivers may wait for flaggers to let them through or take the signed detour route.

KEY PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

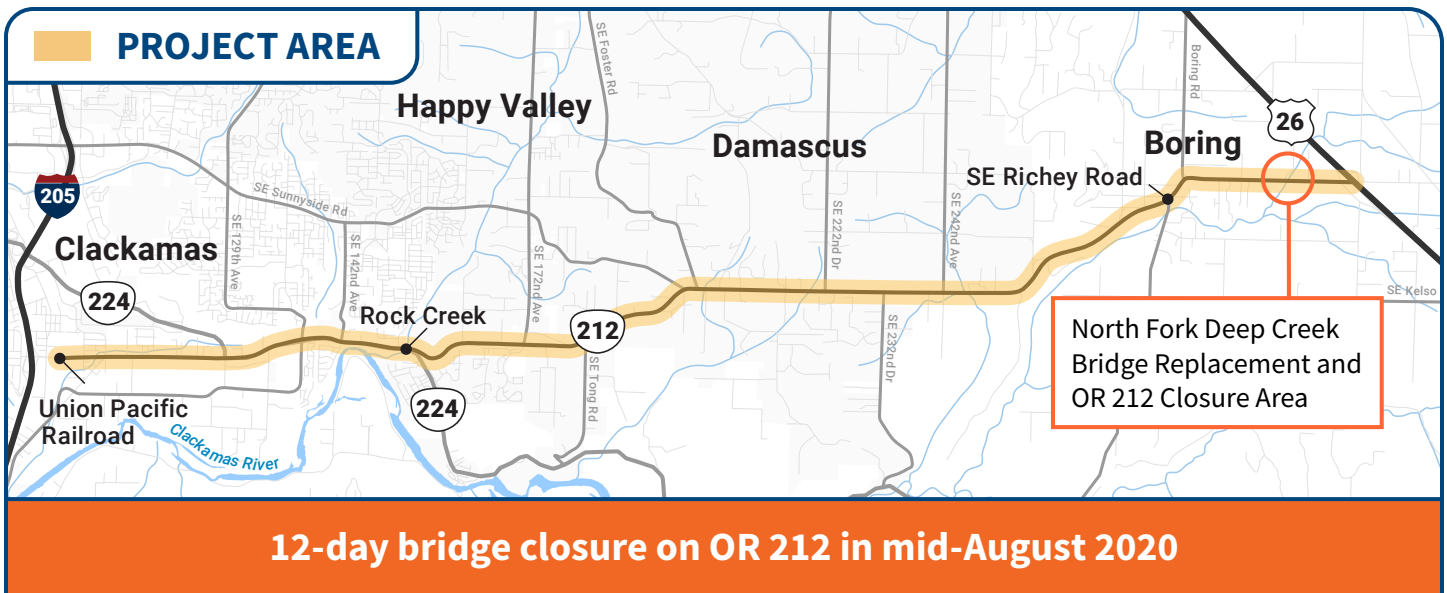
- Repair and repave OR 212.
- ADA-compliant sidewalk curb ramps and pedestrian facilities at 26 intersections.
- Installation of fish-friendly bridge at North Fork Deep Creek, currently carried under OR 212 via corrugated pipe.

- Head north on SE Orient Drive.
- Turn left onto SE 282nd Avenue.
- Turn right onto OR 212 west.

OR 212 east

- Turn left onto SE 282nd Avenue.
- Turn right onto SE Orient Drive.
- Turn right onto SE Compton Road for OR 212 west or turn left onto SE Compton Road.

OR 212 east to U.S. 26 west

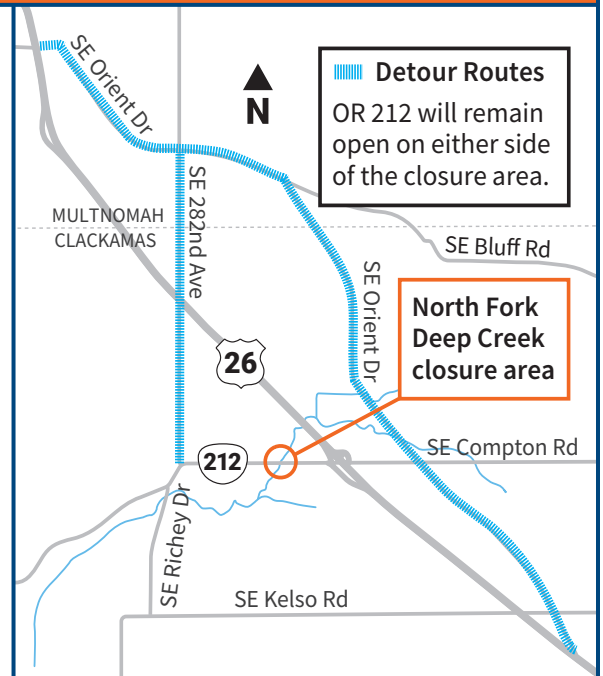
- Turn left onto SE 282nd Avenue.
- Turn left onto SE Orient Drive.
- Turn left onto SE Palmquist Road and follow to U.S. 26 west.

U.S. 26 east to OR 212 west

- Turn left onto SE Orient Drive.
- Turn right onto SE 282nd Avenue.
- Turn right onto OR 212 west.

U.S. 26 west to OR 212 west

- Turn right onto SE Orient Drive.
- Turn left onto SE 282nd Avenue.
- Turn right onto OR 212 west.
